#### **Learning activities**

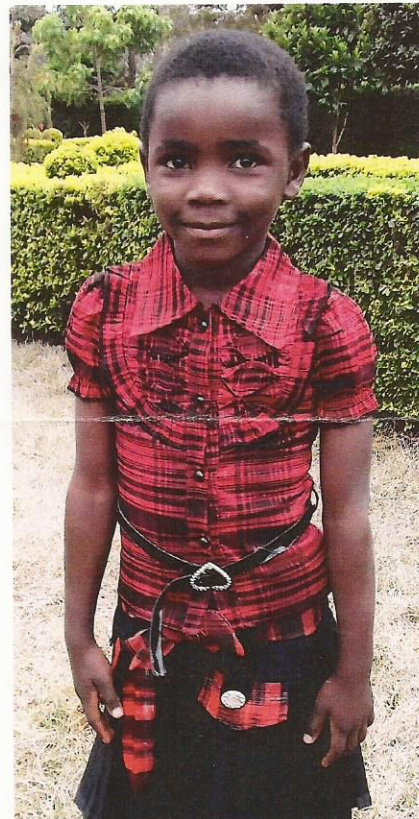

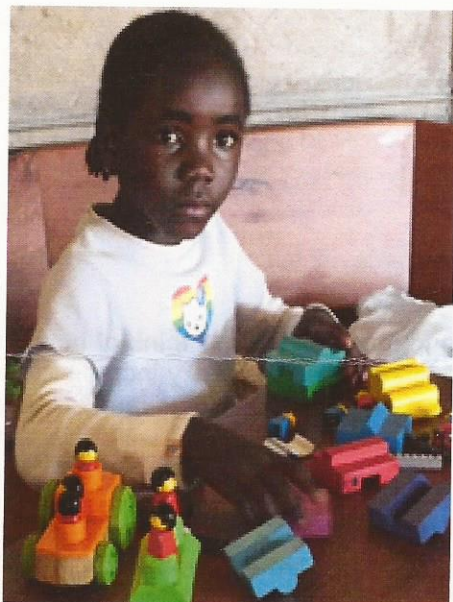
