

Race to the Roof

From the Basement to the Attic!

Get ready for this exciting game of pursuit where no two games are alike. Can you make it to the attic before anyone else? Starting at the front door, roll the die and race through the different rooms until you reach the attic. Roll a 6 and take a chance – you might leap forward or take a huge step backwards!

For 2-4 Players, Ages 5+

Contents:

- 1 Game Board
- 16 Room Cards
- 20 Object Cards
- 4 Wooden Playing Pieces
- 1 Die



Object of the Game:

Try to be the first to bring your playing piece from the front door to the window in the attic.

Getting Started:

- Carefully punch out all the room and object cards.
- Connect the two game board pieces to form the house.
- Place each of the 16 room cards on the game board. It's up to you where they go - this way the game will be different every time!
- Shuffle the object cards and place them face-down in a pile.
- Everyone picks a playing piece and places it at the front door.
- Put any extras back in the box.

Let's Play!

The youngest player goes first.

- Take turns rolling the die and moving your piece the number of spaces thrown.
- If you roll a 6, pick up an object card. Find the exact object shown on the card somewhere in the house and move your playing piece to the red space just below it. This means that you may be moving forward – but beware – you might also have to go back!
- Once the object card is drawn, it can't be reused, so put it back in the box. If the object cards are used up and you roll a 6, just move your piece 6 spaces.

Winning the Game:

Whoever reaches the attic window first is the winner. But there's a catch! You have to roll the exact number of spaces needed to get there. (Example: If you're 4 spaces from the window, you have to roll a 4. If you roll a 5, you can't move ahead and lose your turn.)



Helpful Information:

- Younger children may need help familiarizing themselves with the different rooms of the house. Before starting the game, make sure everyone is able to identify and find all the objects in the rooms.
- Have children discover and describe all the details they see in the different rooms of the house.
- You can also ask children to verbalize what's happening as they're playing the game. (Example: "Where is the object card telling you to go?" "What other objects do you see in that room?")
