

HOW TO PLAY

You can play Scary Bingo with up to seven people. First, select a player to be the caller (don't worry, you can take it in turns for following games).

The caller takes the big game board and assembles the monster head box, filling it with all the tokens.

All other players take a bingo card each.

The caller takes a random spooky character from the box and calls its name out, e.g. 'Clarence'.

If a player has Clarence on their card they can cover him with a counter. Before selecting the next token, the caller should place the token on the game board.

The aim of the game is for players to mark all the monsters on their cards. When your card is complete, shout 'SCARY BINGO!' This player is the winner!

For the next game, players should take a new bingo card each and select a new caller.

EXPERT PLAYERS ONLY

To play a quick round of Scary Bingo, concentrate on marking off five of the creepy creatures in just one line of your card (horizontal, vertical or diagonal).

Or expert players can give a description instead of the names of the monsters. For example, 'a green monster with four arms, three eyes and lots of teeth' would be Jarvis.
